GoAmerica and PCTEL Will Enable Roaming Between 2.5G and WiFi Networks

PCTEL's innovative roaming capability, which will be offered as part of GoAmerica's combined WAN/LAN solution later this year, will provide a single point of access to GPRS, CDMA 1xRTT as well as 802.11 networks. The software will be compatible with GoAmerica's award-winning Go.Web and Mobile Office solutions.

When we announced our intention to offer a combined WAN/LAN solution, we cited simplicity of solution as a priority, said Joe Korb, executive vice chairman of strategy and strategic alliances at GoAmerica. By integrating PCTEL's technology into our offering, we are intending to provide something truly unique for the corporate customer. PCTEL, an eight-year old company that motivated the industry to adopt cost effective soft modems, recently acquired the assets of cyberPixie. That company developed software that facilitates roaming billing and 802.11 client card installation. PCTEL immediately enhanced these products to enable 802.11 to cellular roaming.

It is gratifying to collaborate with GoAmerica on this outstanding opportunity just 11 weeks after our acquisition of cyberPixie, remarked Marty Singer, PCTEL's chairman and CEO. GoAmerica has impressed the industry with an ability to anticipate the wireless needs of corporate America. A LAN supplies high-speed connectivity to a group of computers in close proximity, allowing any person with a wireless LAN card to benefit from high-speed wireless connectivity within a 300-foot radius of the network base. Currently, LAN service is based on 802.11b technology, known as Wi-Fi, and boasts speeds up to 11 megabytes per second (an average of 10 times faster than the a T1 land-line office connection). Wi-Fi access has quickly gained popularity on corporate campuses and in heavily trafficked areas -- known as hot spots, such as airports, hotels, conference centers and coffee shops, where businesspeople often stop to connect to the office.
